Meanwhile, cat no.2, the white one, was found in Alsager on Lawton Green Estate, crying incessantly at someone's door to be fed. We were called out to scan. This cat was an entire male, with no chip, unlike the other – all done. We advised that the cat should not be fed as it was encouraging it to stay, in the hope that it would go home. It was a very difficult situation as he refused to go and continued crying in the early hours. After he had been put on Facebook, a

She has turned out to be such a sweetheart, giving head rubs and cuddles galore. And **MAUDE** and **MILDRED** went to fosterer **LAURA** in Bucknall. They are approx. 8 months old and very probably pregnant! **MAUDE** is black

and white and **MILDRED** is tabby and white, they are booked in at the Vets on 4th March and **BUDDY** on 8th March. Watch this space! **BUDDY** has come on in leaps and bounds, so affectionate, but the girls have regressed, being very shy. Where did they come from? Obviously from different litters. We appeal again – **GET YOUR CATS NEUTERED.** We dread the months ahead and what they may bring.
