Larry is a shy boy; he likes to climb and explore the room and enjoys playing with pieces of ribbon and his own tail.

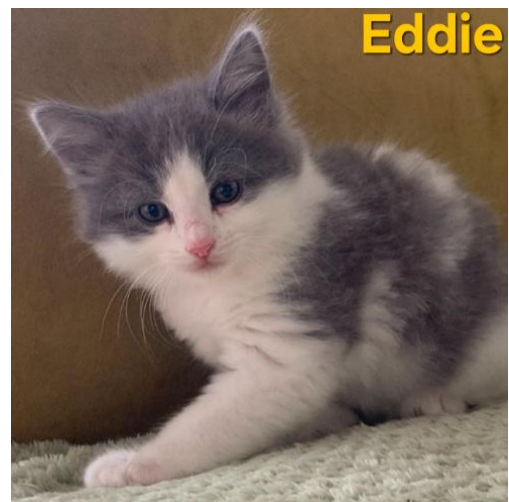

CAT NEWS



Busier and busier, with few rehoming and more appeals, all genuine, everyday. BREEZE and BUBBLES, two adorable black kittens aged 4 months, were left, in a bag on fosterer OLIVIA'S doorstep one day, it is quite concerning when people either leave their pets on your doorstep, or try to ring and ask if they can bring them in. how do they know we have space for them? Luckily OLIVIA took them in out of the goodness of her heart, although still fostering DAISY, a grey kitten, luckily, DAISY'S colour was popular it seems, as after many, many enquiries she has now been rehomed. BUBBLES and BREEZE will be looking for a home in the near future. BLACK CATS ARE BEAUTIFUL!

There have been several RTA's to attend and scan, it is always heart-breaking to do

this, especially if they are chipped and the bad news has to be broken to the owners. RTA's are on the increase, it is well worth peace of mind to either have your garden cat-proofed, or have a catio.

We have been busy trapping, relocating and returning to their own environment several local cats, MILO from Mow Cop and FRANK from Sandyford, in an effort to stem the ever-increasing tide of kittens, kittens, kittens. We have been attending to another stray from Scholar Green, FOX, who has many issues with his health, sadly, FOX was PTS which was a devastating blow for his feeder.

Another 'community cat' in Alsager, SMUDGE, had an abscess on his paw, which was treated, and he was returned to his feeder.

It is always rewarding when attending strays, to find they are chipped. This was the

case recently with FREYA, a calico female found in Alsager. However, her chip was not up to date with change of address, which prolonged her being returned to her owner.

PLEASE CHECK IF YOUR CHIP DETAILS ARE UP TO DATE.

The 5 kittens found in a box outside a shop are now weaned and ready for their 1st vaccination, when they will be looking for their new homes. All delightful, playful little purr machines, who enjoy play sessions and cuddle time. Look out for BEATRICE, BEAUTY, BERTIE, BASIL and BECKY.

We are pleased to report that all the cats at MANOR FARM have been caught and relocated. However... there was a tabby mum, named NETTIE, with 3 kittens underneath a pile of furniture. Many thanks to SARAH and WENDY for daily feeding and observing where NETTIE had hidden the kittens, enabling

LISA to catch NETTIE in the trap and carefully collect the young kittens, leaving LUCY, the older black and white mum, very skinny BUT PREGNANT! Where will NETTIE and LUCY go?

In desperation, we approached CAITLIN (JANETTE'S DAUGHTER) and asked if we could use the empty cattery in standing in her garden doing nothing, despite appeal after appeal for someone to take it. Of course, CAITLIN said yes, bless her, and after a spruce up, NETTIE and kittens, and LUCY were installed. However... overnight LUCY produced 5 kittens, one of which was sadly dead. LUCY decided to have the kittens in a litter tray, despite having a lovely birthing box with Vet Bed installed, we decided to leave her in the litter tray for the time being, but sadly, LUCY ate two of her kittens, leaving just 2. We are given to understand that mother cats

will do this when they feel threatened – she had a lot to cope with and she is now successfully rearing the 2 kittens. A big THANK-YOU to SARAH and WENDY for doing ‘a morning shift’ at the cattery, feeding, cleaning and socialising the kittens. However – we only have the cattery for a limited time, so the appeal for fosterers remains.

At the moment we are feeding 60+ cats and kittens every day, so the need for food is paramount. THANK-YOU ASDA and TESCO for having a food trolley for us.

We have many adult cats still needing homes, kittens soon grow up and older cats have a great deal to offer. Despite delightful TILLY and TANSY'S pictures being in last month's PAWPRINT, only 1 couple agreed a home, and that fell through. Just because a cat is a little shy and hangs back rather than coming to greet you, does not show its true

nature. Please be patient, and you will be rewarded 100 fold. People who know cats will understand this.

Our last intake is a young, very pretty tabby female, has obviously been somebody's cat, as affectionate, but no chip, and remains unclaimed. Guess what? YES, SHE'S PREGNANT. She can only stay with her present fosterer for a short time, so we are looking for a foster home for MAE.
